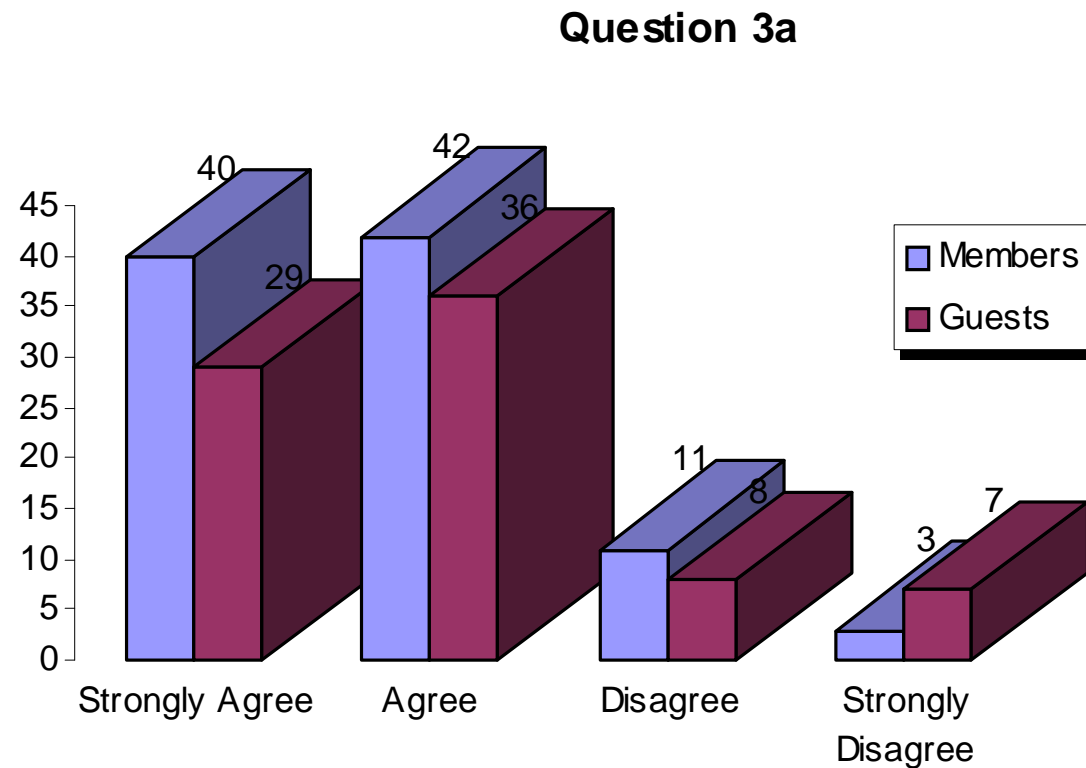




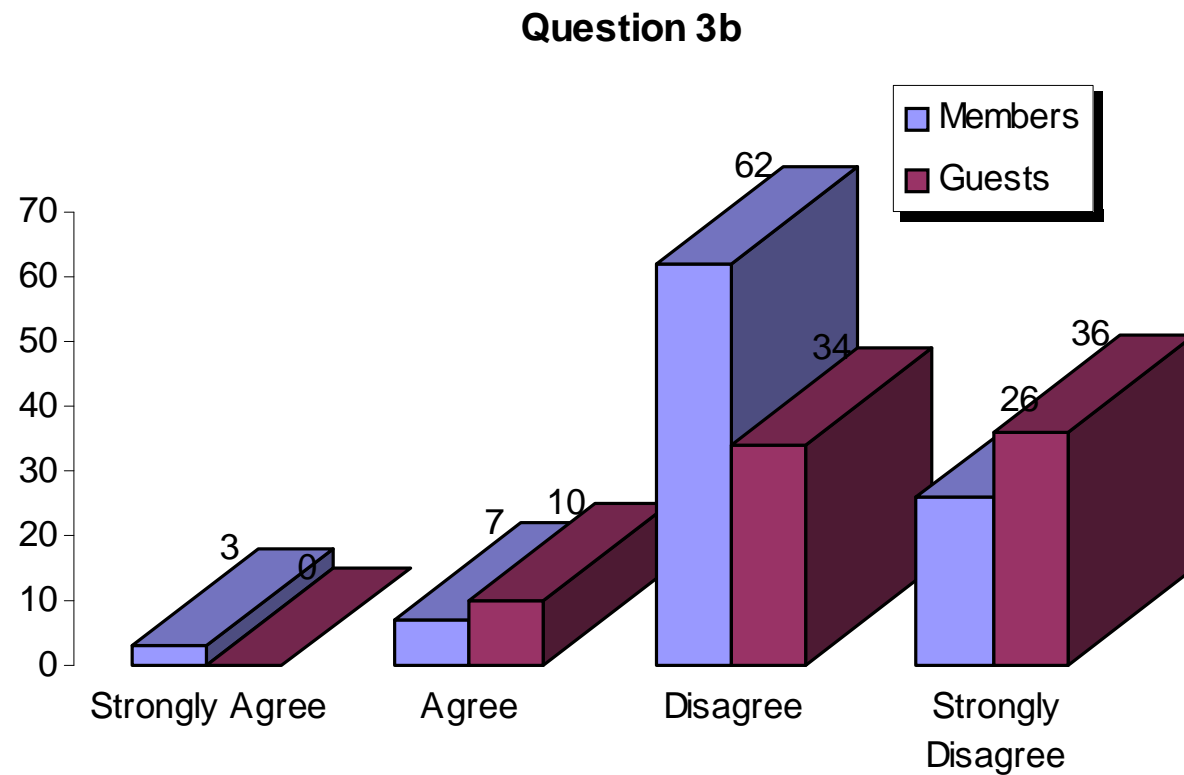
It's great if the Church can be involved in all kinds of creative mission, but frankly, money raised from parishes should go back to parishes.



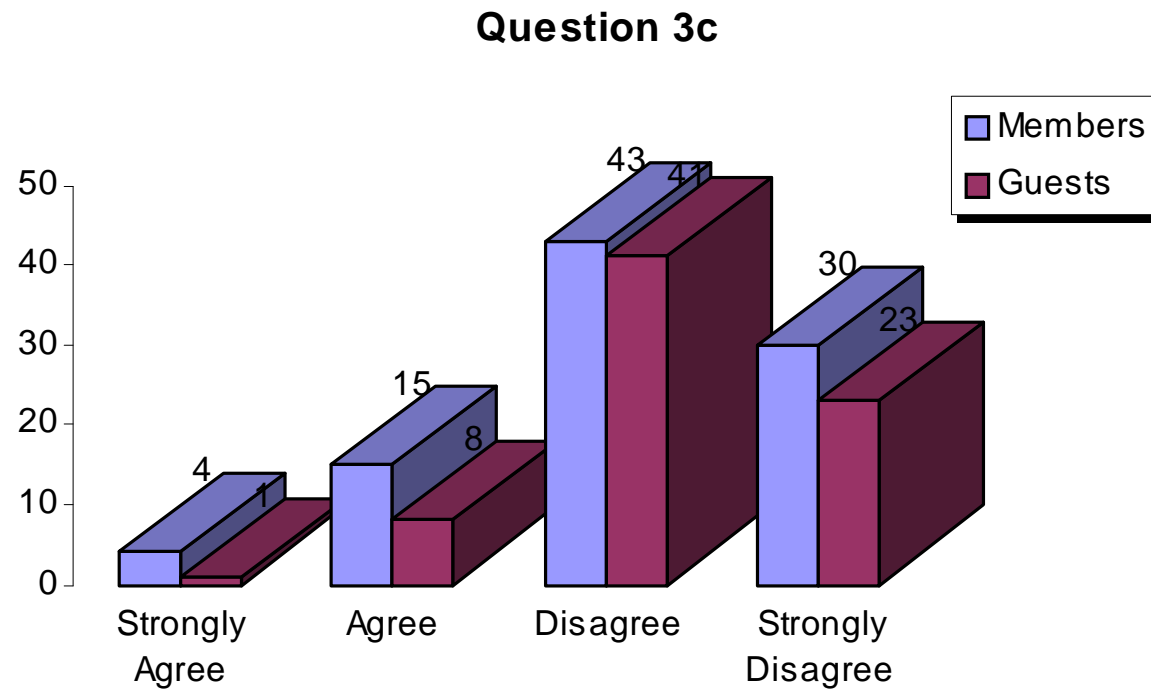
Individuals and churches should give proportionately to their size and relative affluence.



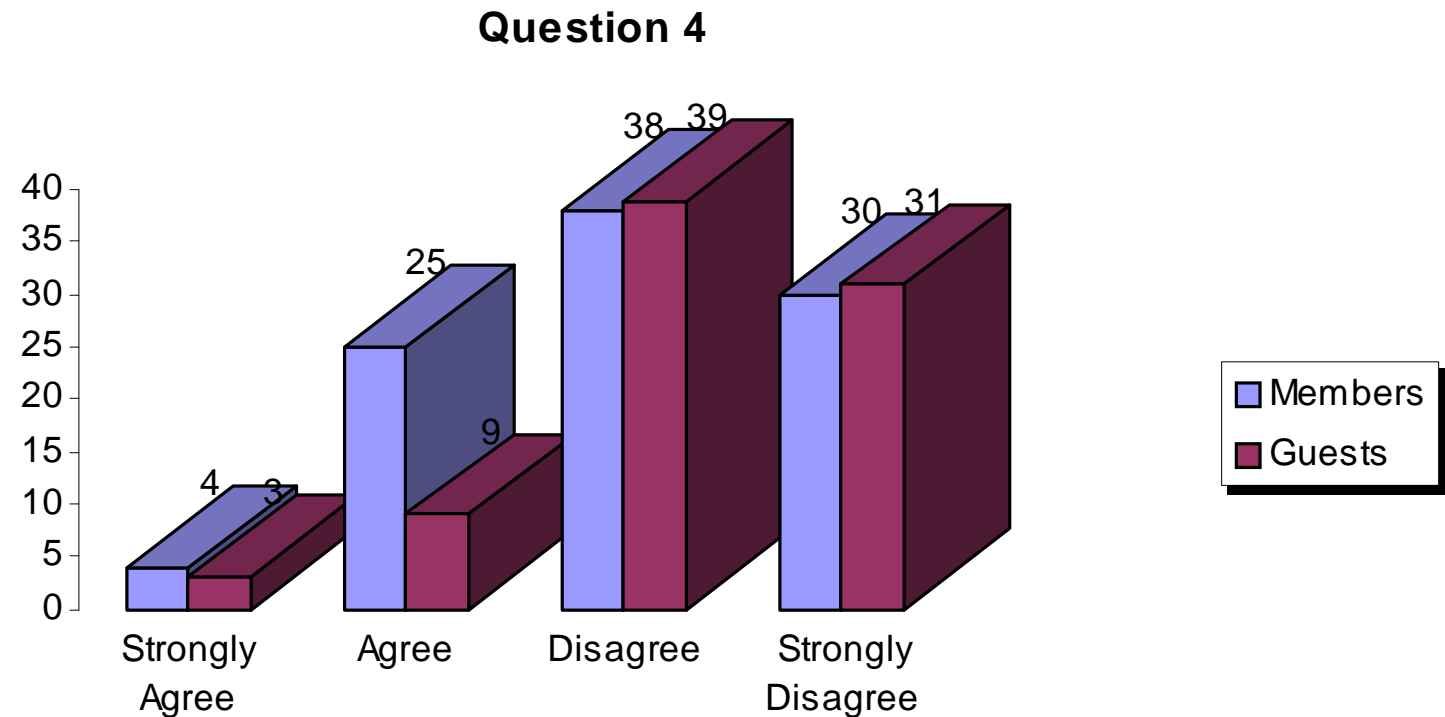
A church that gives a lot to fund mission in the Diocese should expect to get a lot back too.
